## NOTICE OF RACE

**TCYC Spring Tune-Up Regatta 2014**  
**Sponsored by the Granville Island Boat Yard**  
**Saturday, March 22 2014**  
**Start of first race: 11:00 a.m.**

### **Race Requirements and Prizes:**

All boats with a valid PHRF certificate and proof of insurance, that meet other requirements as stated in the Sailing Instructions below, are invited to participate in the Tiddly Cove Yacht Club Series races.

The race will be governed by the rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing*. Communications will be conducted over VHF channel 68 and racers will be encouraged to monitor this channel. Registered boats will be divided into two fleets, as described in the Sailing Instructions; an overview of the TCYC division breaks is available on the TCYC web site.

Scoring will use the low-points system, with no discards. The Spring Tune-Up Regatta is meant to be used for shaking off the winter cobwebs and getting boats and crews ready for the summer racing season. The race committee will endeavor to run as many short round the cans races as possible.

The top three boats in each division will be eligible for a prize. The Granville Island Boatyard has generously donated a very special grand which will be drawn for among all registered skippers present at the results and awards after-party at the Wicklow Pub located next to Heather Civic Marina.

**Registration is available online at [tiddlycoveyachtclub.wildapricot.org](http://tiddlycoveyachtclub.wildapricot.org). The fee is \$15.00 for non-TCYC boats, and \$10.00 for TCYC members. Payment must be made online only by midnight March 21, 2013.**

**Boats that have not made payment prior to the race will not be scored.**

### **Special Note:**

In addition to being part of TCYC's Fleet Championship series, the Spring Tune-up is one of eight eligible regatta races forming part of TCYC's "Sailor of the Year" challenge (for details see the "TCYC 2014 Racing Season" page on the TCYC web site). *If the crew*

*configuration is “double-handed” for purposes of Sailor of the Year competition, please indicate this as well as the qualifying skipper on the registration.*

Following the race all skippers and crews are invited to retire to Wicklow Public House (formerly Stamp’s Landing Pub) for beer, food, results and prizes.
